Sustainable Procurement Policy

Adopted on 28th November 2025

1. INTRODUCTION

Wynn Macau, Limited (the “Company” or “Wynn”), a developer, owner, and operator of two integrated destination casino resorts, Wynn Palace and Wynn Macau, located in the Macau Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China, is committed to integrating sustainability into all the Company’s procurement activities to reduce environmental impacts, support social responsibility, and enhance economic value across the supply chain. This Sustainable Procurement Policy (the “SPP”) ensures that the products and services Wynn procures align with its sustainability goals, whenever possible.

2. PURPOSE

The primary purpose of the SPP is to align procurement practices with the Company’s broader sustainability guidelines, as outlined in Wynn’s Sustainability Policy and Sustainability Principles. The SPP focuses on key sustainability initiatives, including:

- a) Conserve natural resources, materials, and energy, by minimizing emissions, waste, and water consumption.
- b) Support and promote local small-and-medium sized enterprises (SMEs) whenever possible.
- c) Enhance the recyclability of products and materials.
- d) Reduce environmental and health hazards.
- e) Ensure compliance with ethical standards, fair labor and fair-trade practices.
- f) Protect Biodiversity by prioritizing sustainable sourcing that minimizes ecological impact.

3. SCOPE

Any business carried out by the Company, its subsidiaries, or by its suppliers, sub-suppliers, manufacturers, contracted parties, service providers, and/ or business partners shall fully commit to the application of this SPP.

4. THE SPP REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1. Consideration is given to the quality, life cycle costs and circular economy benefits of products and services, ensuring that the Company’s decisions reflect both immediate and long-term environmental impacts.

- 4.2. Wynn endeavors to prioritize environmentally responsible products and services, particularly those that conserve resources, reduce emissions, and minimize waste. Where criteria have not been previously established, the Company seeks out the most sustainable alternatives whenever possible.
- 4.3. Wynn encourages suppliers, sub-suppliers, manufacturers, contracted parties, service providers, and/ or business partners to incorporate end-of-life programs into product life cycle planning, ensuring a responsible approach to recycling, repurposing, or disposal when products reach the end of their use.
- 4.4. Wynn evaluates the social impact, ethical practices, and compliance of all suppliers, and considers those who offer innovative, sustainable solutions that align with the Company's high-quality standards and provide long-term economic value, while ensuring they meet or exceed environmental, legal, and regulatory requirements.

5. SUPPLIER PARTNERSHIP

5.1. Compliance:

All suppliers, sub-suppliers, manufacturers, contracted parties, service providers, and/ or business partners must comply with both the Company's Supplier Code of Conduct and Supplier Environmental Standards, which outline Wynn's expectations for environmental responsibility, ethical labor practices, and business integrity.

5.2. Continuous Improvement:

The Company engages suppliers in an ongoing dialogue to enhance sustainable practices, recognizing that responsible environmental stewardship is a continuous process. Wynn encourages suppliers to report on their sustainability efforts where possible and are committed to supporting them in strengthening their practices over time to align with Wynn's procurement goals.

6. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING

All suppliers, sub-suppliers, manufacturers, contracted parties, service providers, and/ or business partners, are evaluated based on a range of criteria, including but not exclusive to quality, reliability, compliance with the Company's Supplier Code of Conduct, and alignment with its sustainability goals. This comprehensive assessment and monitoring aim to ensure that Wynn's suppliers, sub-suppliers, manufacturers, contracted parties, service providers, and/ or business partners meet its standards across environmental, social, economic, and operational dimensions.

7. SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

Wynn sets clear goals to monitor and report on procurement practices that align with its sustainability commitments, fostering accountability and transparency across the Company's supply chain.


8. THE SPP ACCESSIBILITY
